# Changelog

This page shows a history of the released versions of Simply Remind Me and the improvements, new features and bugs fixed.

## Version 4.0.3

Date released: 27th September 2023

### Bug fixes

- Corrected a server error when editing a user profile where the country code auto-detection for mobile numbers did not find anything
- The upcoming event dashboard widget now shows dates correctly as "1st" instead of "01st"

## Version 4.0.2

Date released: 25th September 2023

### Bug fixes

- The upcoming event dashboard widget now correctly detects upcoming events that have a specific time

## Version 4.0.1

Date released: 23rd September 2023

### Improvements

- Simply Remind me now includes a brand-new icon in your browser (known as a favicon.) If you save the app to your phone's home screen, it should also now feature this icon.

### Bug fixes

- Corrected a server error when choosing to skip the welcome screen for new user accounts.

- Corrected a server error when using the "Remind me again" feature from email reminders.

# Version 4.0.0

Date released: 23rd September 2023

## Improvements

- Simply Remind Me now features a new, open API (more to come on this soon).
- We also make use of Laravel Livewire for more interactive components and quicker development time.

## New features

- You can now configure your default reminder method. In the Reminder Settings screen (your name → My Profile → Reminder settings) simply choose which you prefer to be your default: email, text message, voice call or push notification.
- Credits for text message and voice call reminders can now be purchased in US Dollars (USD) and Euros (EUR) as well as Pound Sterling (GBP). Simply choose the currency from the drop-down menu when topping up.

## Bug fixes

- Adding a new reminder defaults to "email" as the reminder method - it now follows the same default rules as creating a new event.

# Version 3.4.1

Date released: 28th July 2023

## Bug fixes

- Fixed an issue with the day calculation in the event's "Due in X days" label.

# Version 3.4.0

Date released: 25th July 2023

## Bug fixes

- New reminders default to SMS as intended.

# Improvements

- Events can now repeat bi-weekly and quarterly.
- The “Due in X days” label now takes into account an event’s due time, if it has a specific time.

# Version 3.3.4

## Bug fixes

- Events and reminders on the calendar are now correctly displayed in your local time.
- The "Next Event" dashboard widget now respects your timezone correctly.
- The "Next Event" dashboard widget now shows an event as the next event if it either has no specific time, or if the time has not yet been reached on the day.
